Call for Poster Submissions


CECM Day 2006


The CECM is pleased to present CECM Day 2006, a one day conference on computational mathematics hosted by the CECM, IRMACS and the department of mathematics at SFU.

The meeting will consist of invited talks and a poster session. The CECM invites faculty, students (both graduate and NSERC summer students) and postdoctoral fellows to participate in the poster session. The poster session will be held in the IRMACS atrium.

Up to four prizes (two \$200 and two \$100) will be awarded to students with the best posters. Judging criteria are based on 50% content and 50% presentation.

Registration is required. A registration fee of \$50 per participant will be charged to all participants except invited speakers. The registration fee includes the cost of lunch and breakfast. Students may wish to ask their supervisor to pay for their registration fee. Participants who are unable to pay should contact Michael Monagan (mmonagan@cecm.sfu.ca).





Eligible Posters

The only requirement is that the poster has mathematics in it. It may be applied, pure, computational, or experimental mathematics. If you have already prepared a poster for a presentation at another scientific meeting this year, and you would like also to present it to members of the department, this is appropriate.
